I am a designer, researcher, and educationist from who got interested in the processes involved in CREATION OF KNOWLEDGE, the formation or AWAKENING OF CREATIVITY, INTELLIGENCE, AESTHETICS and its relation to the context/culture. This was due to the contradiction I found in institutionalized education vis-a vis organic learning in traditional non literate communities. My exposure to how children and non-literate learns made me explore the biological roots of learning as well as the loss of biology among the so called educated. My present research is on understanding how children learn the world and world's impact on children's formation and how learning the WORD has impacted (world view, cognitive, construction of knowledge) the so called educated.

Modern schooling is developed in response to the question 'how to teach children. We have readymade knowledge; teachers filled with 'knowledge' and a designated space called schools where the teaching is to be done. Year after year children is brought here to be taught. But once we seriously ask 'how children learn' the

whole structure will crumble. Teaching is conditioning, memorizing and belief making and learning is awakening, exploring and creating knowledge. In the teaching paradigm knowledge is the starting point and in learning paradigm knowledge is the result. In order to understand how children, learn we need to study children in non-coercive environments. There no better space than the cognitive conditions that indigenous communities provide for children.

Summary of work - 1989 till 2024 - No-Teaching Pedagogic experiments

1. Pedagogic experiments with traditional artisans, Craft designer, Mural designer- (www.kumbham.org)

Working in the area of revival of traditional knowledge practices especially related to craft by collaborative design process with traditional artisan. Revisiting traditional knowledge system in order to understand its life sustaining quality as well as the nature centrism. I started my journey in 1989, visited various states like Nagaland, Bengal, Bihar, Orissa, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka. From 1993 onwards he has been living and working among the potters of Aruvacode, a tiny village in Malappuram district of Kerala, which has now become famous for its potters. I brought together a group of villagers when they had lost all their traditional skills due to the influx of cheap industrial substitutes in the village. I explored the possibilities of terracotta suited for the modern context and thus 'Kumbham' was born. Thanks to this small movement. Kumbham is today hailed as a rare instance of a traditional artisan community rehabilitating itself through the very craft they had been alienated from. I have been studying indigenous knowledge systems and believes that it is worthwhile to understand indigenous wisdom. I think that in many cases especially in India even alternative education is explored within the western framework. My involvement with rural/tribal artisans and their methods of creating and transferring knowledge have given me a basis for exploring education from a different point of view.

2. Pedagogic experiments with Design, Architecture, Education, Social work, Management students etc

Exploring/ developing culturally and biologically rooted aesthetic sense and sense of process. Mentoring/ initiating rethinking in foundation program in design and architectural education which forms the basis for further the development of aesthetic sense. Addressing the homogenization of modern space by working with design and architectural institutions to re formulate their foundations studies which is the basis for development of their aesthetic sensibility. Visiting faculty at various design and architectural colleges, craft designer, teachers and parents' workshop to sensitize them to deeper needs of children for respect, existential freedom and autonomy.

The courses I offer are 1. Orientation to be aware of the homogenization aspect and possibility for authenticity. 2. Integration elements of design which involves all aspects that helps in SEEING- (drawing, photography, color/texture etc from nature etc), 3. Material exploration, 4, design of culture specific products, 5. Experiential exploration to understand culture. http://rethinkingfoundation.org/

- **3. Pedagogic explorations with children** Researching on the damages of present education in general with special focus on younger children. Re imagining schools based on the natural and biologically rooted propensity in children to learn and to make sense of the world. (<u>re-imaginingschools.org</u>)
- **4. Research on CHILDREN/PLAY etc** Cognition, aesthetic sense development, Children's natural play, potential of free and self-initiated drawing as a cognitive tool etc The sensing nature; knowing nature workshop I have been doing from 2003 during the April/ May months at Aruvacode, Kerala proved to be of great help in understanding the true potential of children.

The approach I have taken is to initiate enquiry in to understanding and awakening creativity, beauty etc by creating conditions unblocking our own potentials.

One of the major product orientations was towards Architecture [murals, tiles, landscape products, interior products etc] as well as products for kitchen, office and household uses. I am actively working towards developing 'Centre for Craft in Architecture' where new ideas can be generated by providing interactive space for crafts people, architects and designers.
